Region Project: Poster

Fourth graders are studying different regions of the United States. In order to build their background knowledge and show their understanding in varied ways, students will create a research-based poster at home.

<b>Expectations</b>	<b>Points earned towards overall grade</b>
This poster will clearly show the student's name and name of the region studied.	10 points
The poster will correctly teach about the states in this region and what the capital city is in each state. It is clear which capital belongs to each state. All proper nouns will be capitalized correctly and spelling will be perfect.	10 points
The poster will teach about one National Park in this region. There should be at least three facts about the National Park and information about what makes it so special. These facts should be in full sentences, be written in 4th grade language, and prioritize necessary information over "fun facts."	10 points
The poster will teach about the natural resources in this region. The poster will explain three natural resources found in the region, why they are renewable or nonrenewable, where they can be found, how they can be used, and what products they make. All information will be taught in full sentences.	10 points
The poster will include an area on industry that answers the following concepts in full sentences. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What kinds of jobs do people have?</li><li>• What do people spend money on?</li><li>• What kinds of needs and wants can this region supply to customers?</li></ul>	10 points
The poster will teach about fun facts or interesting pieces of information you learned while researching this region. These facts will be in the form of captions, small text boxes, or creative text features. The poster will include between 3 and 8 images, maps, or pictures. They do not need to be in color but color/artwork should be included somewhere on the poster.	10 points
The poster will be complete and submitted to the teacher on or before May 2, 2018 at 8:10am.	20 points
All facts will be clearly and accurately presented in 4th grade language. The project may include typed or neatly written information. All pictures and papers will be securely attached to the poster so they don't fall off during their time displayed in school.	20 points
