Region Project: Google Slides

Slide	Expectations	Points earned towards overall grade
1	This slide will include the title, student's full name, and one map of only the region you studied.	10 points
2	This slide will correctly teach about the states in this region and what the capital city is in each state. It is clear which capital belongs to each state.	10 points
3	This slide will teach about one National Park in this region. There should be at least three facts about the National Park and information about what makes it so special.	10 points
4	This slide will teach about the natural resources in this region. It will include examples of natural resources and information about whether or not these natural resources are renewable or nonrenewable.	10 points
5	This slide will teach about the industry of this region. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What kinds of jobs do people have?• What do people spend money on?• What kinds of needs and wants can this region supply to customers?	10 points
6	This slide will teach about fun facts or interesting pieces of information you learned while researching this region.	10 points
