In order to prepare for the test, you may take your book home to study. Chapter 3 starts on page 51 in the textbook .

All 4th graders will take the test on Monday, March 12, 2018.

For the test you should be able to:

- Write one of the 10 Commandments in your own words. Explain why you chose that commandment.
- Define the words:
 - Covenant
 - Sacred image
 - Faith (belief in God) (p. 65)
 - Kingdom of God (p. 65)
 - Mercy (p. 65)
- Explain how the main idea of the first three commandments are how to love God. (p.52)
- Name the second and third commandment. (p. 52)
- Know that when we worship God we love and serve him as the one true God. (p.54)
- Explain who Abraham is and what covenant he entered into with God.
- Explain how God gave Moses the 10 Commandments to share. Be able to explain why God gave us the 10 Commandments. (p. 52)
- Explain why Jesus wants us to pray in private. (p. 64)
- Explain how the prayer, “Our Father,” connects to the first and second commandments but that it sums up the Gospel message of Jesus. (p. 68)
The Lord’s Prayer helps us learn how to respond to the Ten Commandments.

Some things to study in the book are:

- Reread about St. Teresa of Avila (page 56) and study what she said we should do to become closer to God. (live simply and pray often)
